

At the event of a large-scale earthquake while on campus

Get under a desk and remain there until the quake ends. Do not panic or run. Follow the staff's instructions.





If you are using fire in the laboratory, turn off the heat and gas. Also be careful of any boiling water.

Be careful of falling books and bookshelves in the library. Also be careful of tableware and any fire in the cafeteria.





Stay away from any glass windows or doors. Head for the evacuation area (sports ground).

The elevators should automatically stop at the nearest floor and the doors should open. In the case of the elevator not functioning, press the emergency button and make contact.





Should an earthquake occur while driving to campus, stop the car on the left side of the road, and turn on the radio for the latest updates. Do not make your way to the university, unless it is safe to do so.

Above all, remember to deal with the situation rationally and calmly.
